FIERCE CONFLICTS IN SANDZAK ON THE HORIZON

April 26, 2013

- Having established full control over the Islamic Community in Macedonia, Kosovo and Montenegro to ensure its economic and political domination in the territory of ex-Yugoslavia (with the exception of Slovenia and Croatia) Turkey is after "rearranging" the Islamic Community of Bosnia-Herzegovina and imposing a new concept on Serbia – the concept of a "third" Islamic religious community in Sandzak.

Minister Sulejman Ugljanin's recent ultimatum to the Serbian government for his signature under the ruling coalition agreement is closely connected with his role in the project.

Unlike the earlier concept advocated by Turkish Foreign Minister Ahmet Davutoglu with the helping hand from two Bosniak members of the Serbian cabinet, the latest one has its advocate in Turkish Reis Mehmet Gormez who has already formed a group of "dissatisfied imams" led by Makic and Lekovic.

The main ideologue of the concept, Minister Rasim Ljajic, is supposed to ensure the official Belgrade's support. To him, this initiative opens the door to a more influential role at Sandzak's political scene: if adopted the initiative would make him the number one for the Islamic community in Serbia, but could also split the Sandzak Democratic Party up in two currents, one supporting the Islamic Community of Serbia led by Adem Zilkic and the other standing for the establishment of a third Islamic community.

Due to his good ties with Turkish leadership, his colleague, Ugljanin, is tasked with arranging contacts between high representatives of the two countries.

Turkey will be taking no steps to implement the concept until Serbia's leadership gives it a green light.

This is evident in the overall atmosphere of bilateral visits by high-level officials of the two countries and their calls for strengthening Turkey-Serbia cooperation.

The group of dissatisfied imams is now working in the field, propagating the concept among their colleagues and believers. Their propaganda has been very strong in the region of Sandzak for some time now.

This "third" Islamic community – to be active in Sandzak only for starts – would be named "United Islamic Community in Serbia" and led by a new chief mufti.

The whole plan was developed in Ankara in late December when a group of Sandzak imams paid a visit to Turkey. The media reported that the group had audiences with Reis Gormez and Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan. Gormez's Department of Religious Issues of Turkey would be financing the activities of the third Islamic community but controlling it as well.

Interestingly, the new concept implies the establishment of one Islamic community in Sandzak to start with. The mesihats in Presevo and Belgrade, the later already the seat of the Riyaset of the Islamic Community of Serbia, would be autonomous at first and then incorporated as fait accompli into the new model.

According to the plan, the third Islamic community would leave out Mufti Muamer Zukorlic, officials and employees of the present-day Sandzak-seated Mesihat. Zukorlic would get a "take it or leave it" offer.

The implementation of the concept is already in full swing. At the next stage Davutoglu is supposed to get a green light from the state leadership. Then Gormez would pay a visit to Sandzak to give it the final touch.

The imams tasked with the propaganda are already active. The plan is to impose the media blockade on officials of the Islamic Community in Serbia and Zukorlic.

At the same time, with financial assistance from Turkey, those imams are supposed to win over as many as possible Sandzak imams so as to totally undermine the two existing Islamic communities. They have been promised full assistance from local self-governments formed by Ugljanin's SDA and Ljajic's SDP. Emir Elfic, former leader of the Bosniak Democratic Community (BDZ), also offered to assist generously.

As the new initiative has become an open secret to Bosniak believers, tensions have been growing in Sandzak for some time now. Tensions could easily lead to conflicts, especially among those loyal to Ugljanin's SDA and to the mesihat of the Islamic Community in Serbia.

It is common knowledge that SDA supporters are loyal to the fictional Riyaset of the Islamic Community of Serbia established in 2007 when a group of imams raised their voice against mufti Zukorlic. For his part, Zukorlic blamed it all on Ugljanin. Conflicts, some of which included the use of arms, were on long after the split.

A fait accompli threatens with new schisms and conflicts in Sandzak that could be more serious than those following the developments in 2007 and play into the hands of Serbia:

Serbia could role-play a peacemaker, throw the ball of responsibility for the stability of Sandzak – a precondition to EU accession – in someone else's court and proclaim it all its success (on the course towards EU), especially in the aftermath of the wave of protests against the Serbia-Kosovo agreement.
